TITLE: WASTE COOKING OIL/GREASE

Regulatory Citation: Article VI, Section 64(a), Rensselaer County Sewer District Regulations, 40 CFR Part 112

Applicability: Waste cooking oil / grease

Purpose: Ensure that waste-cooking oil is managed properly

Person or Department Responsible: Food Service Manager, Valleycats
Director of Environmental Health & Safety (EHS)

Schedule: As needed

Procedures: Waste-cooking oil will be placed in the 55 gallon drum labeled, "Waste Cooking Oil". The drum must remain in good condition, leak proof, and kept closed except when adding grease. The drum will remain on a spill pallet to ensure grease spillage is contained.

Spills of grease to sanitary and storm drains must be prevented. Any spills or leaks outside of the containment area should be cleaned up immediately to maintain sanitary conditions and prevent oil from reaching the storm or sanitary sewer systems.

When the grease drum is 80% full, the Valleycats Food Service Manager will contact the approved grease recycler. .

Record keeping: A copy of the waste pickup documentation should be retained to document the periodic waste collection.
